Hon'ble Chancellor expressed his satisfaction that within the short span of time (nearly 4-5 months) Pimpri Chinchwad University, Pune has set a benchmark not only in the field of Engineering, IT, Management, Sciences, and Pharmacy but administratively as well and hope the University will cater the needs of the student community.

The Vice Chancellor (I/c) Dr. Manimala Puri greeted the Hon'ble Chancellor and all the respected members presented, followed by a detailed power point presentation about University updates, academic delivery & curriculum, research/patent, industry tie-up, infrastructure development, new and future programmes approval from respective council & AIU membership, etc.

Item No. 13: PCU achievements and accolades The same is attached as **Annexure – L**

The Pro Vice Chancellor, Dr. Rajeev Bhardwaj apprise the GB members about the marketing campaign run for the admissions year 2023. The members were apprised of the 10, crore plus impressions, 50+ plus millions audience reach, 16, 00,000 clicks, and 55,00,000 communication resulting in 4238 paid applications finally converting into 1148 admissions. The Hon'ble GB members were told that the cost incurred per lead is INR 354 and per admission, the cost is INR 28490 which is reasonably very less in comparison to the other universities acquiring admissions and bearing the cost for admissions. The Pro VC gave a detailed description of the ATL marketing activities and BTL marketing activities. Many events were attended during the admission session by the marketing team within Maharashtra and out of Maharashtra. For the International Outreach Activities Countries like Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Nigeria, Tanzania, Kenya, and South Africa were explored and fortunately three students from international destinations also took admission in PCU. Dr. Bhardwaj also apprised the GB members about the admission target of academic year 2024-25. He told that the targeted admission for 2024-25 is 2050 and the target for the paid form is 7980, Dr. Bhardwaj gave a detailed outreach plan for Maharashtra and PAN India. The GB members were very happy to hear about the international tie-ups, delegate visits, bilateral agreement with 34 Universities and corporate MoUs signed by the institutions. Dr. Bhardwaj further told about the research achievements of the faculties of PCU. The members highly appreciated the research work carried out by the faculty members.
